



Allegan County Residents Is your home in need of repairs?

Need help with the cost?

Allegan County currently has funding available for single item repairs.

Basic Qualifications for assistance (more detailed information available upon request):

- ❖ The home must be a single family owner occupied home
- **Property taxes** must not be in arrears and **homeowners insurance** must be in place on home.
- Must provide ownership documentation in the form of a recorded deed.
- ❖ Mobile homes and modular homes located in a mobile home park **DO NOT** qualify
- Mobile homes and modular homes on privately owned land qualify but assistance is limited to current value of unit
- ❖ Total Gross Household income must be less than 80% of Area Median Income as determined yearly by HUD

Assistance Information:

- ❖ Maximum Assistance is \$5,000.00 assistance amounts below \$2,500.00 will not require repayment Assistance amounts \$2,500.00 & more will require signature of a **0% no interest note and mortgage** agreeing to repay the funds to Allegan County at the time the property is sold, refinanced, ownership changes or it ceases to be your principal place of residence with 50% of the amount forgiven after 5 years.
- ❖ Eligible Repairs are furnaces, hot water heaters, well/water, septic/sewer, plumbing, electric. Handicap ramps & other repairs reviewed on a case by case basis. Roof repairs/replacements only considered on homes constructed after 1978 and are reviewed on a case by case basis.
